MB1/Y1 Copies of a lecture by Lieutenant Commander George Mountbatten, second Marquis of Milford Haven, on Einstein's theories, part of the 1922-3 syllabus of the Royal Naval Staff College, Greenwich; press cuttings and a letter concerning Einstein's theories 1921-3

MB1/Y10 Papers, largely concerning the deaths and funerals of Sophia Nikolaievna, Countess de Torby, wife of Grand Duke Michael of Russia, (mother of Nadejda, second Marchioness of Milford Haven), in 1927; of Victoria, dowager Marchioness of Milford Haven (formerly Princess Louis of Battenberg and Princess Victoria of Hesse), in 1950; Nadejda, Countess of Torby, dowager Marchioness of Milford Haven (widow of George, second Marquis of Milford Haven), in 1963; and Princess Alice of Greece in 1969

MB1/Y11 Papers, including the birth certificate of Lady Tatiana Mountbatten, daughter of Nadejda, Marchioness of Milford Haven, and George, second Marquis of Milford Haven, 1917; the death certificate of George, second Marquis of Milford Haven, 1938; letters in response to the maiden speech of David, third Marquis of Milford Haven, in the House of Lords, 1948; photographs and letters written to Lord Mountbatten, mainly concerning his brother George, second Marquis of Milford Haven 1909-79

MB1/Y12 Instructions, timetables, etc., for a visit to Delhi by King George V, with two photographs of the Taj Mahal 1911
