Letter from Earl Mountbatten of Burma, First Sea Lord, Admiralty, Whitehall, London, to first Viscount Montgomery of Alamein "Monty", 20 October 1955, commenting on Montgomery's statement on the deployment and integration of British armed forces. "Although I admire you and your excellent record as a soldier, I do feel that generalisations by generals should never be made, and this is a case in point."
