# **Terms of participation**

The event is organised by the Web Science Institute (WSI) at the University of Southampton.

The WSI ["the organiser"] was nominated by the Web Science Trust to host the WSTNET Web Science Summer School 2019 (WWSSS'19).

By registering for this event, you agree to the following terms of participation:

## 1. Registration
