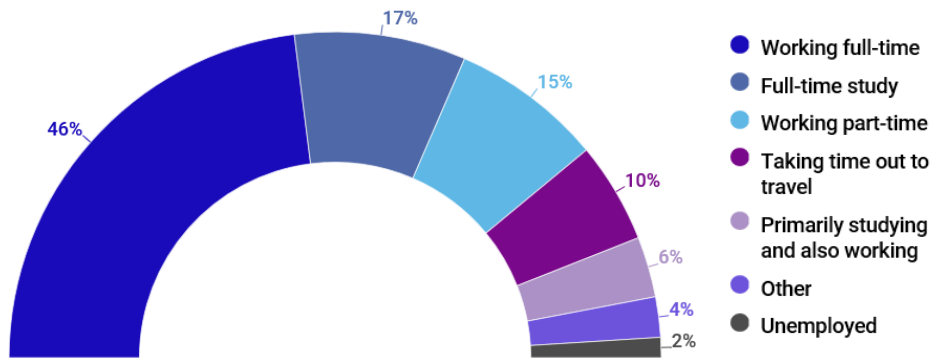


Destinations of 2016/17 Graduating Cohort – Politics and International Relations

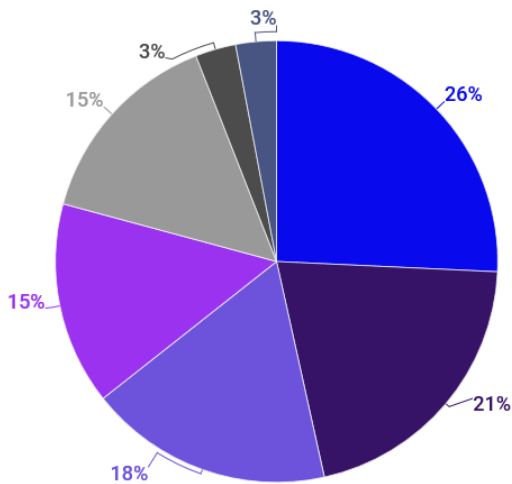

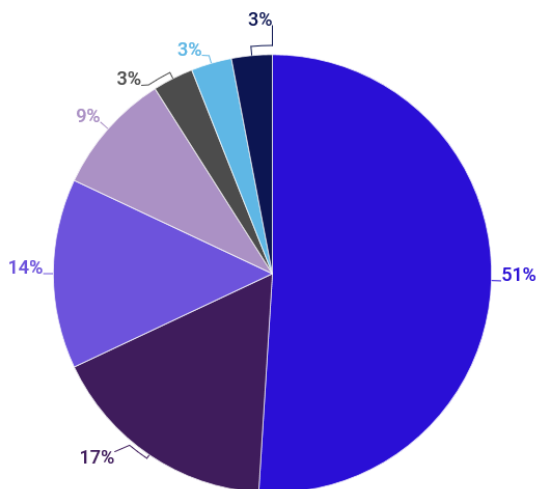
