We invite you to submit a maximum of two original photographs that best encapsulate your view of Geography. Each entry should be accompanied by a short commentary (maximum 150 words) that explains how the submitted photograph represents your view of Geography.

The winning entry will receive a prize of **£300**, runner-up prize **£150**, third prize **£50**
The Closing date for entries is **11pm, 10th October 2014**

Submit your entry to geographycompetition@soton.ac.uk. Entries should be in jpg format with a maximum of 300 dpi and a file size of no more than 5MB. All entries must submit details of the location and/or subject, camera setup and context for the photograph in the body of the entry email. Contest terms and conditions of entry and voting

Entry rules

- The contest is open to all Geography and Environment staff, students and alumni.
- Maximum of two entries per person.
- The image must be your original work.
- You must be the owner of the copyright of images entered.
- University of Southampton does not accept any liability for the publication of unlawfully reproduced images.
- All images should adhere to the theme of the contest.
- Computer-generated or computer-altered images will not be accepted. Likewise, artwork and illustrations will not be accepted.
- To enter, email the image to geographycompetition@soton.ac.uk by the closing date specified within the contest, together with an explanation of how the image best represents your view of Geography.
- Images should be submitted as jpg.
- Each jpg should be a maximum of 300dpi and 5MB in file size, with your name and title of the photo in the file name.
- All entries must submit details of the location, camera setup and context for the photograph in the body of the entry email.
- University of Southampton takes no responsibility for corrupted or late entries.
- By entering your image, you grant the University of Southampton the right to use the image in a charity calendar with attribution.
- The winners consent to the use of their image, name and/or photograph in any publicity carried out by the University of Southampton, without further compensation.
- The winning images will be judged by an online vote after shortlisting by the competition organisers.
- The competition organisers' decision on all matters relating to the competition is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- The organisers reserve the right to withhold prizes if, in the opinion of the judges, the quality of entries falls below the standard required.
- The winning images and nine further commended images will be used in the Geography and Environment 2015 charity calendar.
- Prizes are non-transferable.
- Entries should be received by 11 pm on October 10th 2014.
- The competition is not open to the organisers.

Winners will be announced at a reception in the Shackleton Building (Building 44, University of Southampton) at **4pm on Wednesday 26th November 2014.**

Voting rules

- The competition winners will be decided by a vote open to all Geography and Environment staff, students and alumni.
- Voting will take place on a shortlist of entrants selected by the competition organisers.
- Competition entrants are not allowed to vote for their own entries.
- Voting will close on the day stated on the competition advertising.
- The Winners will be identified after the closing date for voting, based on the images with the highest number of votes.
- We reserve the right, at our discretion, to disqualify or discount any entrant, image or vote connected to votes cast by unfair means.
