July	Apply for your UK ID Card: Once you have enrolled, you will be able to order your new ID card online. Do NOT apply before the 28 <sup>th</sup> June or you will be charged.	Remember to keep your existing student ID card with you when travelling to the UK as additional proof of your student status. You will be able to collect your new ID card at the International check-in on 17 <sup>th</sup> September
July	Students to attend the Visa Application Centre Take the TB test at an approved clinic Students will be required to pay the Immigration Health Charge, (£300 to be paid covering 2 years of study).	Students will need to pay in cash. The priority visa service is recommended which should take 3-5 working days (approximately RM 1000). This will allow access to the NHS whilst in the UK.
When you receive your visa	Book travel to the UK to arrive at Heathrow Airport. Planned dates for arrival: - 16 September (MEng Mech/Aero) - 19/20 September (MEng EEE)	We advise you to wait until you have your visa before booking your travel arrangements to the UK. You can then proceed, as directed by the USMC Student Office.
