A903 Peninsular War items: letter from Vice Admiral Collingwood

Letter from Vice Admiral Cuthbert Collingwood, first Baron Collingwood, Commander in Chief of the Mediterranean fleet, to Captain General Don Tomas de Morla, Governor of Cadiz, relating to transportation for French troops captured at the battle of Baylen, the safeguards for £20,000 raised for provisions and the restrictions on vessels withdrawing from Spanish ports, 28 Jul 1808; enclosed are a translation of the letter and a letter, in Spanish, to Don Tomas de Morla concerning the Collingwood letter, 29 Jul 1808

A850 Peninsular War items: letter from the Marques del Campo to the Conde de Floridablanca

Contemporary copy of a letter, in Spanish, from the Marques del Campo (Spanish ambassador in London) to the Conde de Floridablanca, detailing British plans for attacking the Spanish colonies in the Americas and suggesting precautions to be taken, including the communication of the document to all Spanish viceroys in America, 4 June 1788. Enclosed is a memorandum in three parts: 'Relacion de una expedicion al mar del sur projectada por varios particulares en la ultima guerra'; 'Carta del Capn. Roberts sobre una expedition al mar del sur'; and 'Projecto de una expedicion a la costa de Yucatan y a la de Honduras'
