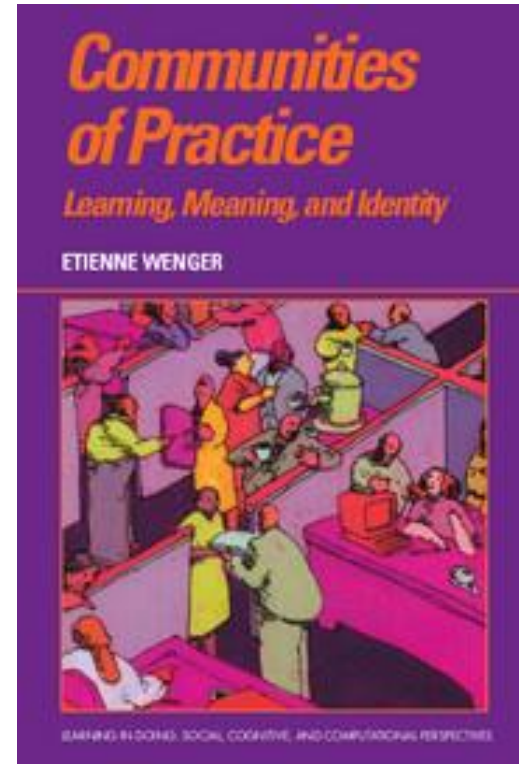

- Regular rhythm



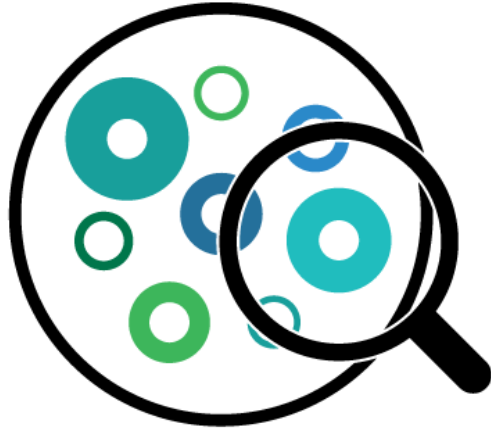
