- Type a list of up to 5 keywords
- Include the details of the author(s)
- Upload paper (or description of installation/portfolio) in the extended abstract format: **2-6 pages** long including references, font size 12, 1.5 spacing. It can include diagrams or tables up to a maximum of 3 pages.

Discuss the content and format of your submission with your supervisory team.

Deadline for submissions: **31 January 2018**

Notification of acceptance: 28 February 2018

Full conference programme published: mid-March 2018

There is **no registration fee** for doctoral researchers from the University of Southampton. External participants will be charged £45 for attending the Conference, or £90 for attending both the Conference and Conference Dinner.
