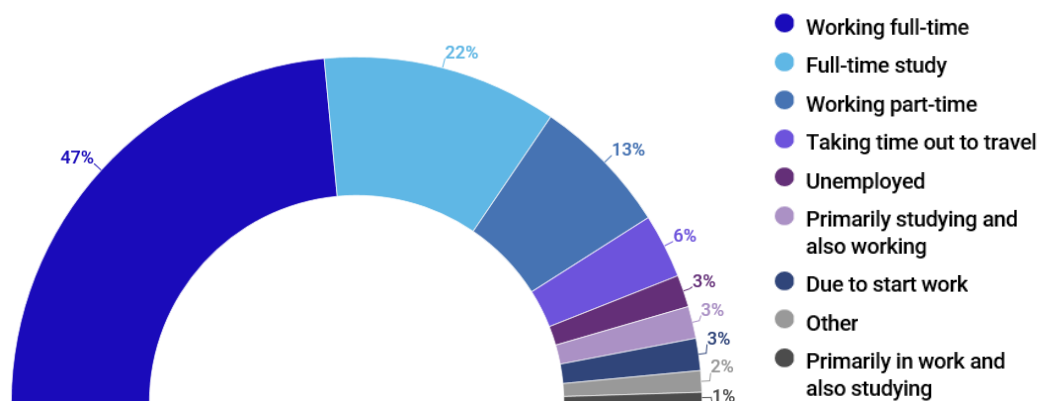


Destinations of 2016/17 Graduating Cohort – Ocean and Earth Sciences

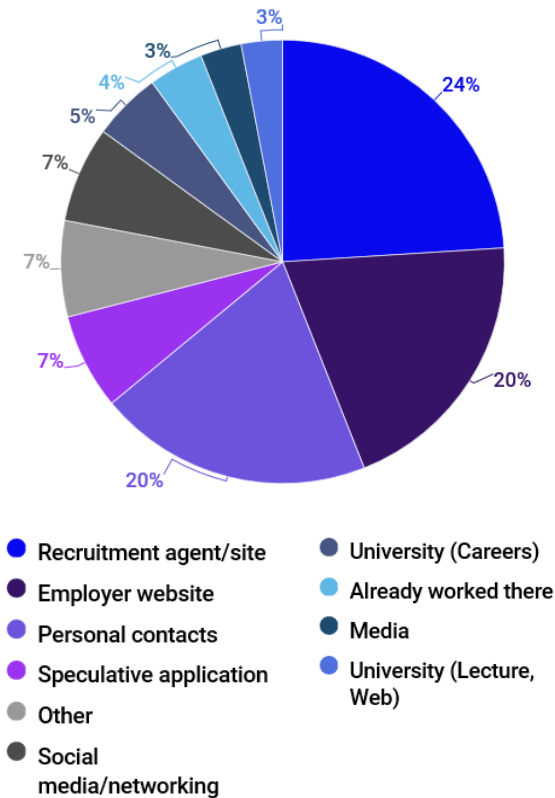

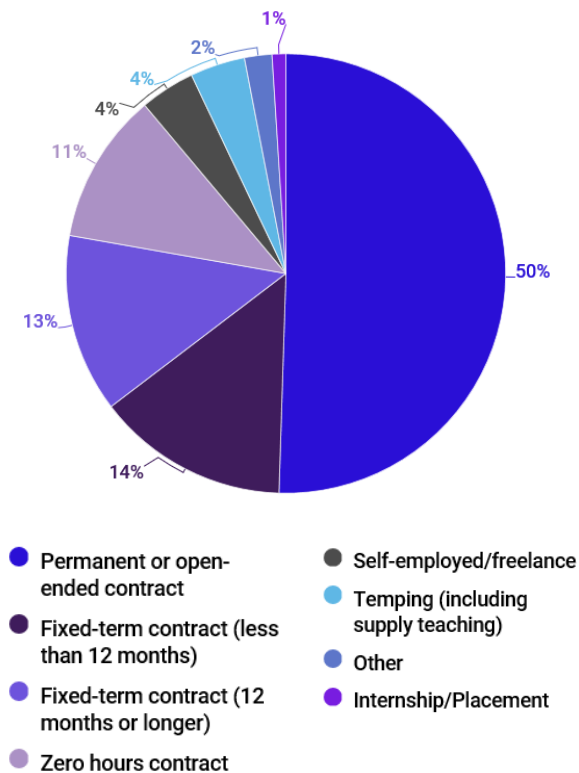
