

Southampton World Cup 2018 Photo Competition

Terms & Conditions

1. This competition is open to students currently studying during the 2017/18 academic year, and returning or new students who will begin their studies in 2018/19. This includes students studying at undergraduate and postgraduate levels, who are based at any of our campuses, including Distance Learning programmes.
2. This competition will commence at 12:00 BST on Thursday 14th June 2018 and all entries must be received by 12:00 BST Wednesday 4th July 2018. The International Office accepts no responsibility for any entries that are incomplete, illegible, corrupted or fail to reach the International Office by the respective closing date. Proof of sending is not considered a valid receipt. Entries via agents or third parties are invalid.
3. Entrants may represent a World Cup football team of their choice and are not limited to their home country.
4. Entrants may submit as many entries as they wish, but no entrant may win more than one prize.
5. To enter, entrants must post a photo on Instagram with a caption tagged with #UoSWorldCup and @uos.international and be an existing follower.
6. All correctly completed entries will go through an initial screening by a member of the International Office. Entries which gain the highest number of 'likes' during the competition will be put forward to a judging panel. The judging criteria includes: originality, caption and passion. The winner will be the person whose entry has received the highest scores by the judging panel. If an entrant has submitted multiple entries, only their highest placed entry shall be considered.
7. The prize for the winner with the highest scored entry will be a £100 Amazon gift voucher.

8. The prize for the second highest scored entry will be a £50 Amazon gift voucher.
9. The prize for the third highest scored entry will be a £25 Amazon gift voucher.
10. The Amazon gift vouchers are subject to the terms and conditions set by Amazon.com, Inc.
11. The judging panel's decision is final. No correspondence will be entered thereafter.
12. The prizes are non-transferable and no cash alternative will be offered.
13. Prizes are subject to availability. In the event of unforeseen circumstances, the International Office reserves the right (a) to substitute alternative prizes of equivalent value and (b) in exceptional circumstances to amend or foreclose the competition without notice.
14. The winner will be notified via email or Instagram after the competition and judging has been concluded. The winner must claim their prize within 14 days of the International Office sending notification. If the prize is unclaimed after this time, it will lapse and the International Office reserves the right to offer the unclaimed prize to a substitute winner selected in accordance with these rules.
15. Amazon vouchers will be sent by e mail to winners at a designated e mail address, who must acknowledge receipt of the prize by e mail to international@soton.ac.uk
16. By entering this competition each entrant confirms that his/her entry is their creation and not protected by copyright or other intellectual property rights. Entrants will keep the International Office harmless from any claims in relation to their entry that the entry infringes the personal or proprietary right of any other person. By submitting an entry, each entrant grants to the International office a perpetual, royalty-free, non-exclusive license to edit, publish, modify, make available and distribute the entry throughout the world in any media now known or hereafter invented. Entries must not have been utilized for any other photo competition. Only the single entrant and owner of the profile used for entering the competition is legible for prize winning in instances of group photos.
17. Each entrant also confirms that anyone depicted in an entry has given their permission for the inclusion of their image in the entry and the use of the entry including their image by the entrant and the International Office. Photos must not contain images of anyone under the age of 18 years old.
