## CREW

Before Christmas we were given the great news that Macmillan Cancer Support have agreed to continue funding the CREW study. This is why we have sent you a 4 year follow up questionnaire and next year we will be sending you a 5 year questionnaire.

Even though we have been collecting data for 4 years, each questionnaire you complete and return is still very valuable to us, even if you have moved on and feel you have made a good recovery following your treatment for colorectal cancer. This is because we are using the results and information provided to us in those questionnaires to understand how life unfolds for people with colorectal cancer, and what things make life more difficult and also easier during the treatment and recovery of colorectal cancer.

The study is still being overseen by the Macmillan Survivorship Research Group, at the University of Southampton. We are currently busy analysing data from your questionnaires up to 2 years post surgery. We will be posting summaries of our findings on the website, however if you would like more information on our results please do drop us an email.
