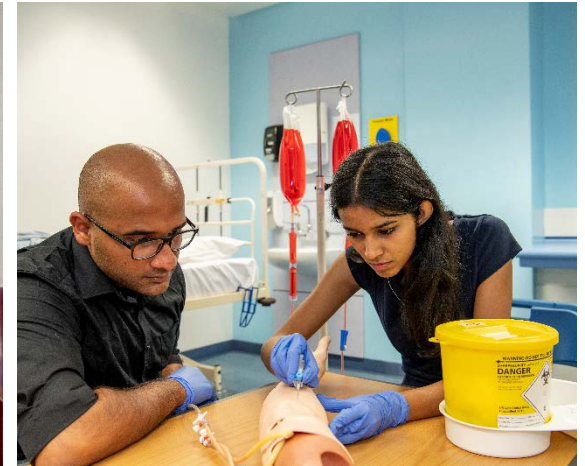
# Widening Access to Medicine Virtual Residential

- Replaces our usual residential
- Year 12 students
- 12 – 14<sup>th</sup> April
- Free event for eligible students
- Gives student a taster of life as a medical student
- Live and offline activities through blackboard collaborate
- Access to the Medical student mentor
- Guidance after the event to support your medicine application

# Eligibility Criteria

- In order to qualify for the BM6 virtual event you will need to be studying A Level Biology and one additional science, be under 18, and meet at least **three** of the following eligibility criteria:
  - First generation applicant to higher education
  - Parents, guardian or self in receipt of a means-tested benefit
  - Young person looked after by a Local Authority
  - In receipt of a 16-19 bursary or similar grant\*
  - In receipt of free school meals at any point in Years 10-12
  - Living in an area with a postcode which falls within the lowest 20 per cent of the Index of Multiple Deprivation, or be a member of a travelling family
