March/April	Visa Webinars/Skype calls with Visa Officers in UK campus.	These arrangements will help in your preparation of your visa application and inform you of any changes to the visa process. The skype calls are an opportunity for you to ask any questions about any part of your own visa application
April	You will received information about the Theme Choice, Optional Modules and Individual project.	Once you have selected your module options, you will need this information when you apply for your ATAS. (Academic Technology Approval Scheme) certificate.
April	<p>ATAS clearance – if your programme of study requires ATAS clearance then you must obtain that before you apply for visa.</p> <p>Apply for ATAS clearance certificate: https://www.gov.uk/academictechnology-approval-scheme </p>	<p>MEng Mech/ Aero students only.</p> <p>ATAS applications typically take 30 working days to obtain and an ATAS certificate is only valid for 9 months before making a visa application. If you have an ATAS clearance certificate but it is older than 9 months when you make your visa application then you will need to apply for a new one for your visa application</p>
May	You will receive your formal University accommodation offer	You will need to accept your accommodation offer online to confirm your place. You will need to make a prepayment of £150. The rest of your first instalment of hall fees are due 7 th October 2019.
April/May	Select your Individual Project Choices	Programme staff will inform you of the correct method to select your Individual Project. You will be able to do this between 10:00AM 2 May – 16:00PM 24 May 2019.
May/June	<p>Send your approved ATAS certificate to UoSM Student Office for verification. The verification will be done by the Faculty Student Office in UK. You must complete and submit the online visa application before you are able to book your appointment
July	Apply for your UK ID Card: Once you have enrolled, you will be able to order your new ID card online. Do NOT apply before the 31 st July or you will be charged.	Remember to keep your existing student ID card with you when travelling to the UK as additional proof of your student status. You will be able to collect your new ID card at your International Registration appointment
July/ Aug	Students to attend the Visa Application Centre. (Kuala Lumpur/Sabah/Sarawak) Students will be required to pay the Immigration Health Charge via online when makes the visa application.	Students will need to pay in cash for the priority visa service. The priority visa service is recommended which should take 3-5 working days (approximately RM 1000). This will allow access to the NHS whilst in the UK.
When you receive your visa	Book travel to the UK to arrive at Heathrow Airport. Planned dates for arrival: - 15 September (MEng Mech/Aero) - 18/19 September (MEng EEE/EFY)	We advise you to wait until you have your visa before booking your travel arrangements to the UK.
August	Book your place on Meet and Greet (which will include booking early accommodation)	The full details of Meet and Greet will be published on the Transition Webpage. Deadline for booking is Friday 30 August 2019.
