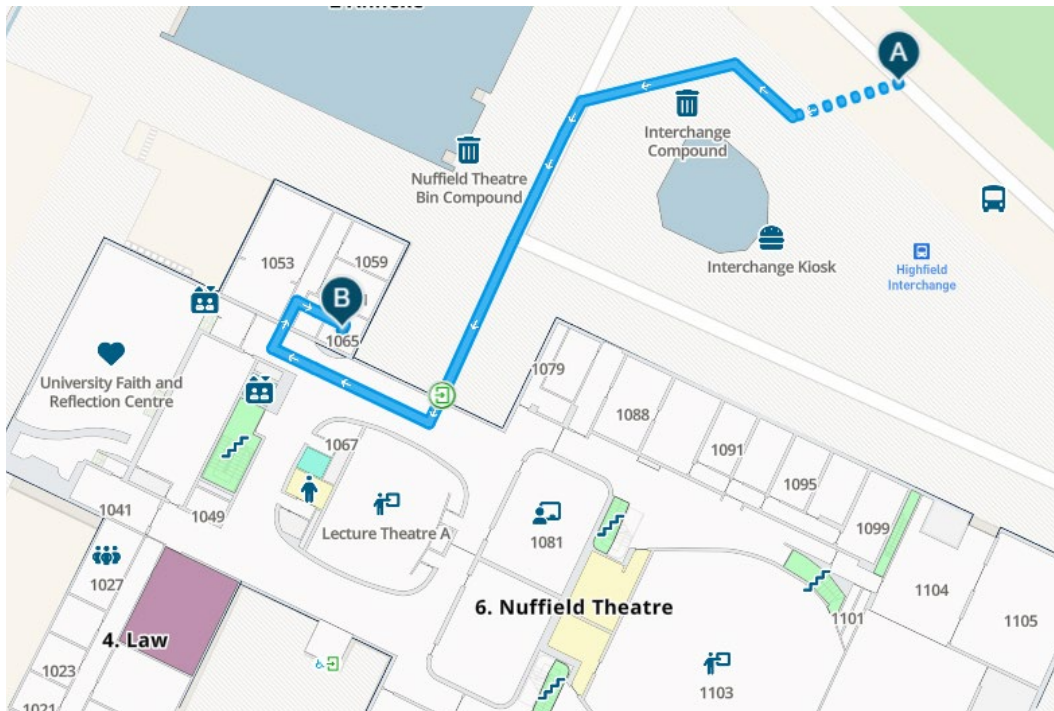

# From Highfield Bus Interchange

The route from the Highfield Interchange to the Faith and Reflection Centre Quiet Room is not far. Follow the route marked on the map. There will be also signage to direct you to the room.



1. Begin at the Highfield Bus Interchange.



2. Go around the Interchange Kiosk:



3. You will find the entrance to the Nuffield Theatre (Building 6):



4. Head through the automatic doors, then turn right.

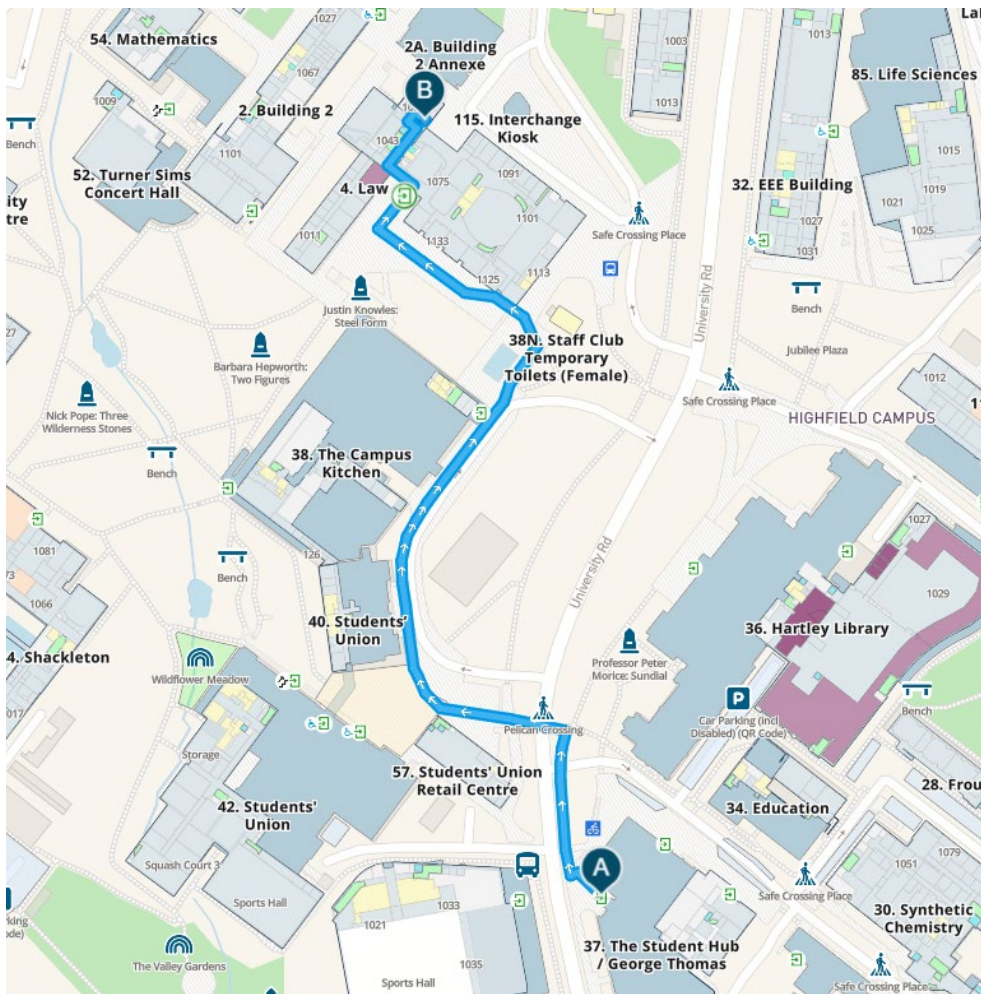




5. Head towards the double doors. A member of the Student Disability and Inclusion Team will be situated in this area to greet you and sign you in for your activity.



# From The Student Hub



## 1. Begin at The Student Hub (Building 37)





2. Facing away from the entrance to The Student Hub, head right towards Hartley Library and go past the Voi Scooter Parking. Then, cross the road safely.



3. Continue to reach the pelican crossing on your left. Then, cross the road safely.





4. Continue forward to head between the bollards / hedges.



5. Turn right and head past SUSU Building 40.

⚠ **Caution: Vehicles Operating in This Area** ⚠

There may be cars, vans, or other vehicles moving through this area; to help keep everyone safe, be **alert** and take extra care.



6. Follow the path to head past Building 38 and make your way safely around the pond.





7. Continue along the path – Nuffield Theatre will be on your left – and head towards Highfield Interchange.



8. Turn left. Then, continue until you reach the entrance to the Nuffield Theatre (Building 6) on your left.





9. Head through the automatic doors, then turn right.



10. Head towards the double doors. A member of the Student Disability and Inclusion Team will be situated in this area to greet you and sign you in for your activity.
