INLAND (and to Irish Republic).—Letters not exceeding 1 oz., 3d.; 2 ozs., 4½d.; each additional 2 ozs., 1½d. Postcards—single, 2½d.; reply-paid, 5d.

OVERSEAS.—British Commonwealth, territories under British trusteeship, British Postal Agencies in Bahrain, Muscat, Qatar and the Trucial States. Letters: Not exceeding 1 oz., 3d. For every additional oz., 1½d. Postcards—single, 2½d.; reply-paid, 5d.

All other countries.—Letters: Not exceeding 1 oz., 6d.; for every additional oz., 4d. Postcards—Single, 4d.; reply-paid 8d.

H.M. FORCES ABROAD AND H.M. SHIPS IN FOREIGN WATERS.—Surface rates—Letters not exceeding 1 oz., 3d.; for every additional oz., 1½d. Postcards 2½d. AIRMAIL—Forces Air Letter forms, 3d.; letters not exceeding, 1½ ozs., 6d., each additional ½ oz., 6d.; Postcards, 3d.

Parcels

INLAND.—Not exceeding 2 lbs., 2/-; 3lbs., 2/3; 4 lbs., 2/6; 5 lbs., 2/9; 6 lbs., 3/-; 8 lbs., 3/6; 10 lbs., 4/-; 12 lbs., 4/6; 15 lbs., (max to Irish Republic.), 5/-; 18 lbs., 5/9; 22 lbs., 6/6.

H.M. FORCES ABROAD AND H.M. SHIPS IN FOREIGN WATERS.—Not exceeding 3 lbs., 2/6; 7 lbs., 3/9; 11 lbs., 5/-; 22 lbs., (max.), 7/6. **OVERSEAS**.—It is advisable to consult the Post Office Guide.

Newspapers

(Registered at G.P.O.) 3d. per copy for first 6oz., and 1½d. for each additional 6oz. per copy up to 2 lb (maximum).

Printed Papers

INLAND (and to Irish Republic).—Not exceeding 2 ozs., 2½d.; 4 ozs., 4d.; for every additional 2 ozs., 1½d. (max. 2 lbs.).

H.M. FORCES ABROAD AND H.M. SHIPS IN FOREIGN WATERS.—First 2 ozs., 2d.; for every additional 2 ozs., 1½d. (max. 6½ lbs.).

OVERSEAS.—First 2 ozs., 2½d.; each additional 2 ozs., 1½d. (max. 6½ lbs.).

Magazine Post

CANADA (including NEWFOUNDLAND) ONLY.—Not over 6 ozs., 1d.; above 6 ozs. up to 1½ lbs., 1½d.; for each additional ½ lb. up to 5 lbs., (max.), ½d.

Commercial Papers

OVERSEAS.—Not over 8 ozs., 7d. (minimum charge) For each additional 2 ozs., 1½d. (max. 5lb. to British Commonwealth, territories under British Trusteeship, British Postal Agencies in the Persian Gulf, 4lb. to all other countries).

Money Orders

INLAND.—Poundage for sums not over £10, 2/-; not over £20, 2/2; not over £30, 2/4; not over £40, 2/6; not over £50, 2/8 (Max. £50). Advice of payment, 6d.

INLAND TELEGRAPH.—Poundage at ordinary rates, plus official telegram of advice 5/- (Irish Republic, 6/-) minimum. Private message 5d. per word.

OVERSEAS.—See Post Office Guide.

Recorded Delivery

Charge 6d.—Carrying compensation up to £2.

The service provides that a Certificate of Posting be given to the Sender and that the Post Office obtain a receipt on delivery.

No service to Irish Republic.

Postal Orders

On orders of 6d. and 1/-, poundage 2d.; 1/6 and every multiple of 6d. up to 5/-, and every multiple of 1/- up to £1 1s., 3d.; £2 and every multiple of £1 up to £5, 6d. Two stamps to the value of 5d. may be affixed to orders up to 4/6; to the value of 11d above 4/6.

Inland Telegrams

ORDINARY.—The first 12 words (including address), 5/- (6/- to Irish Republic) (minimum), each extra word, 5d.

GREETINGS.—On Standard or Birthday Greetings form: 12 words for 5s. 6d. (minimum), each extra word, 5d.

On Wedding Greetings form: 12 words for 5s. 0d. (minimum,) extra word, 3d.

PRIORITY.—Single address Ordinary or Greetings telegrams can receive priority on payment of an extra charge of 2/- each telegram (service not available to Irish Republic).

To H.M. FORCES BASED AT HOME.—Inland rates but a Forces address of any length counts as five words only.

On Sundays, Good Friday and Christmas Day all classes of telegram, except press telegrams, cost 1/6 extra. In Scotland the extra charge applies to Sundays only.

Registration

INLAND (fees in addition to postage).—Carrying compensation up to £20, 1/9; up to £40, 1/10; and so on up to £400 at the rate of an additional 1d. for each £20.

OVERSEAS (not applicable to magazine post packets for Canada (including Newfoundland) or to parcels).— Compensation generally for total loss only up to £2 18s., 1/9.

National Savings Certificates

These may be obtained at most Post Offices in denominations of 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 10, 20, 50, 100 and 200 £1 units. They are repayable at any time. No person may hold or have an interest in more than 300 units of the Eleventh Issue.
