OVERSEAS.—British Commonwealth, Abu Dhabi, Bahrain, Dubai, Muscat and Oman, Qatar and Sharjah. Letters: Not exceeding 1 oz. 4d. For every additional oz., 1½d. Postcards—single, 3d.; reply-paid, 6d.

All other countries.—Letters: Not exceeding 1 oz., 9d.; for every additional oz., 5d. Postcards—Single, 5d.; reply-paid 10d.

H.M. FORCES ABROAD AND H.M. SHIPS IN FOREIGN WATERS.—Surface rates—Letters not exceeding 1 oz., 4d.; for every additional oz. 1½d. Postcards 3d. **AIRMAIL**—Forces Air Letter forms, 4d.; letters not exceeding 1½ ozs., 6d., each additional ½ oz.. 6d.; Postcards, 4d.

Parcels

INLAND (and to Irish Republic).—Not exceeding 1½ lbs., 2/6; 2 lbs., 3/-; 6 lbs., 4/6; 10 lbs., 6/-; 14 lbs. 7/6; 18 lbs., 9/-; 22 lbs. (maximum), 10/6.

LOCAL PARCELS (excluding Irish Republic).—Rates as above less 1/- at each step.

H.M. FORCES ABROAD AND H.M. SHIPS IN FOREIGN WATERS.—Not exceeding 3 lbs., 3/3; 7 lbs., 5/-; 11 lbs., 6/6; 22 lbs. (max.), 10/6.

OVERSEAS.—It is advisable to consult the Post Office Guide.

Newspapers

(Registered at G.P.O.) Not exceeding 2 ozs., 3d.; not over 4 ozs., 5d.; each additional 2 ozs., 1d. (maximum weight 2 lbs.).

Printed Papers

INLAND (and to Irish Republic).—Not exceeding 2 ozs., 3d.; 4 ozs., 5d.; for every additional 2 ozs., 1d. (max. 2 lbs.).

H.M. FORCES ABROAD AND H.M. SHIPS IN FOREIGN WATERS.—First 2 ozs., 2d.; for every additional 2 ozs., 1½d. (max. 6½ lbs.).

OVERSEAS.—*Ordinary rate.* Single packets. Not over 2 ozs., 4d.; each additional 2 ozs., 2d. *Reduced rate.* (Newspapers, periodicals, books, pamphlets, maps and sheets of music.) Single packets. Not over 2 ozs., 2d.; each additional 2 ozs., 1½d.

Phonopost Packets

OVERSEAS.—(To certain countries only) Not exceeding 2 ozs., 7d. each additional 2 ozs., 7d. (maximum 2 lbs.).

Money Orders

INLAND.—Poundage for sums not over £10, 2/-; not over £20, 2/2; not over £30, 2/4; not over £40, 2/6; not over £50, 2/8 (Max. £50). Advice of payment, 6d.

INLAND TELEGRAPH.—Poundage for sums not over £10, 2/6; not over £20, 2/8; not over £30, 2/10; not over £40, 3/-; not over £50 (max.), 3/2, plus official telegram of advice 5/- (Irish Republic, 6/-), minimum. Private message 5d. per word.

OVERSEAS.—See Post Office Guide.

Recorded Delivery

Charge 9d.—Carrying compensation up to £2.

The service provides that a Certificate of Posting be given to the Sender and that the Post Office obtain a receipt on delivery.

No service to Irish Republic.

Postal Orders

On orders of 1/-, poundage 3d.; 1/6 and every multiple of 6d. up to 5/-, and every multiple of 1/- up to £1 1s., 4d.; £2 and every multiple of £1 up to £5, 6d. Two stamps to the value of 5d. may be affixed to orders up to 4/6; to the value of 11d. above 4/6.

Inland Telegrams

ORDINARY.—The first 12 words (including address), 5/- (6/- to Irish Republic) (minimum), each extra word, 5d.

GREETINGS.—On Standard Greetings form: 12 words for 5s. 6d. (minimum), each extra word, 5d.

On De Luxe Greetings form (for special occasions): 12 words for 7s. 0d. (minimum), extra word, 5d.

PRIORITY.—Single address Ordinary or Greetings telegrams can receive priority on payment of an extra charge of 2/- each telegram (service not available to Irish Republic).

TO H.M. FORCES BASED AT HOME.—Inland rates but a Forces address of any length counts as five words only.

On Sundays, Good Friday and Christmas Day all classes of telegram, except press telegrams, cost 2/6 extra. In Scotland the extra charge applies to Sundays only.

Registration

INLAND (fees in addition to postage).—Carrying compensation up to £100, 3/-; up to £200, 3/3; up to £300, 3/6; up to £400, (maximum), 3/9.

OVERSEAS (not applicable to parcels).—Compensation generally for total loss only up to £2 18s., fee 3/-.

National Savings Certificates

These may be obtained at most Post Offices in denominations of 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 10, 20, 50, 100 and 200 £1 units. They are repayable at any time. No person may hold or have an interest in more than 750 units of the Twelfth Issue.
